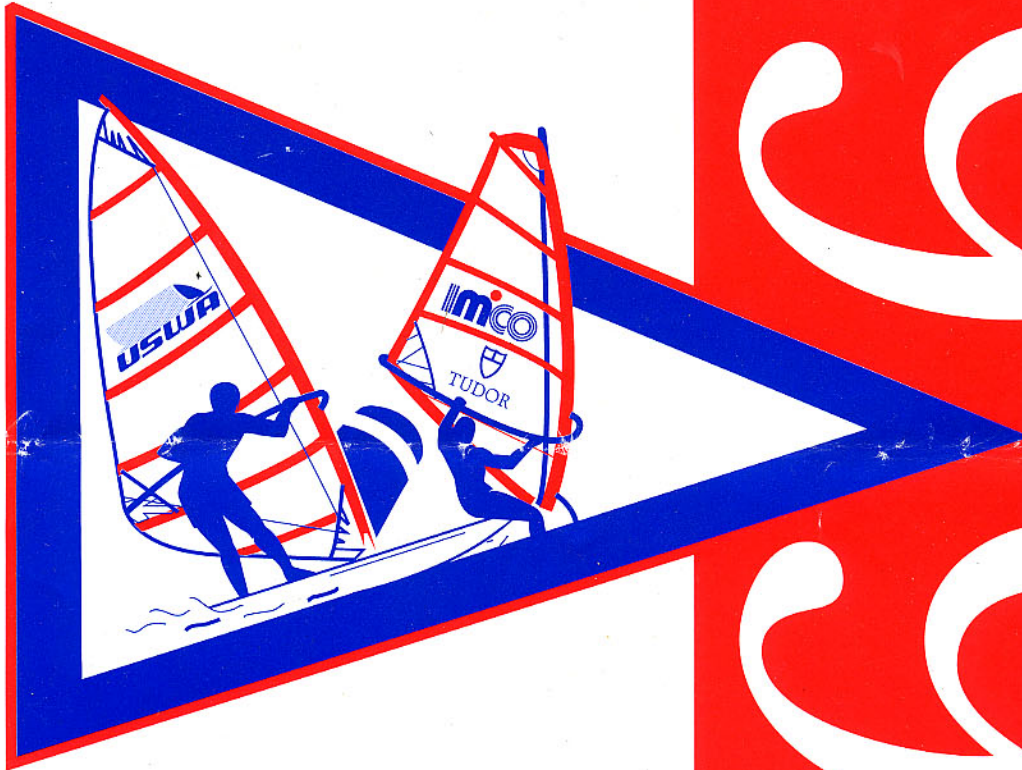

## SCORING

The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix 5.2 of the Racing Rules, will apply. Competitors who start together will be scored against each other (Fleet Scoring). Trophies will be awarded for overall performance in the three official disciplines as follows:

1. Course Racing	50%	70%	80%
2. Giant Slalom	30%	30%	—
3. Long Distance	20%	—	20%

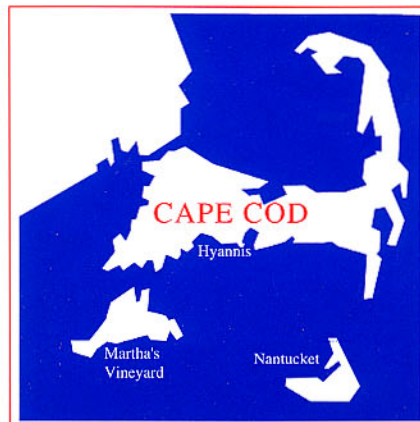

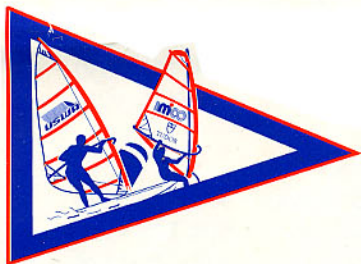
