I am writing this letter in regards to the proposed dredging at the Hyannis Yacht Club. The Trustees of the Hyannis Yacht Club have voted to relieve the Town of Barnstable from any responsibility of damage that may occur to the pier and pilings of the Hyannis Yacht Club during the dredging.

It was further voted to have the Hyannis Marine Service remove the eight (8) pilings in order that the dredge may excavate to the prescribed depth in and around the pier.

Fenner Jr., of Centerville, will become installed as commodore of the Hyannis Yacht Club and I will become a Trustee; however, I will remain in charge of this dredging project and would appreciate very much your keeping me informed as to when the work might start, who receives the bid, etc.
