

HOUSE RULES.

1. THE CLUB HOUSE will be opened at 9 A. M. No member will be allowed in the Club after 12 P. M. at which hour the lights will be extinguished and the house closed.
2. None but members will be permitted to settle for anything furnished by the Club.
3. No Bowling or Billiards will be allowed from 12 P. M. on Saturday until the following Monday at 9 A. M.
4. Members must sign a ticket or pay cash for everything furnished by the Club.
5. Billiards, 20 cts. per hour. Pool, 5 cts. per game.
6. No liquor shall be sold in the Club House.
7. The Superintendent shall on every day deliver to the Treasurer all cash or checks received by him during the preceding day. The Treasurer shall on the first day of every month mail to every member a statement of the amount due from him, other than for dues. Such indebtedness shall be settled by a member within fifteen days from date of said statement and if he does not so pay his name shall be posted in the Club House. If he shall not pay such indebtedness within 30 days the Executive Committee may suspend him from all rights and privileges of membership including that of entering the Club House.
8. None but members and persons introduced as hereinafter provided shall be admitted to the Club House.

VISITORS

Are persons having a usual place of business or residence at Hyannis Port. A visitor may be admitted to the Club House once in fifteen days and not oftener, and a member introducing him should ascertain whether he has been introduced within the past fifteen days. A visitor must be introduced by a member who immediately upon his entrance shall register his name and residence and day of introduction in a book kept for that purpose and affix his own name. A visitor shall not pay cash or settle for anything furnished by the Club but shall in all respects be considered a guest of the member introducing him.

No resident of Hyannis not a member shall be admitted to the Club.

STRANGERS

Are persons not having a usual place of residence or business in Hyannis or Hyannis Port. A stranger may on the request of a member receive from the Executive Committee a written invitation entitling him to all the privileges of the Club House for one week. The name of such stranger shall also be registered in the Stranger Book. The same person shall not again be admitted as a stranger for two months after the date of his prior introduction but he may be admitted as a visitor once in fifteen days according to the rules provided for visitors. Members introducing visitors and strangers are responsible for them.

The Executive Committee may permit visitors and strangers to be introduced at other times than provided in the by-laws.

9. The Club shall be open on Tuesdays and Thursdays of each week to the ladies of members' families and those accompanying them.
10. No member shall use the private property of another member without his permission. All private property shall be at the owner's risk.
11. No member shall have the privilege of introducing more than ten persons in any one month.
12. These rules may be altered, amended or suspended by the Executive Committee.
